

## <u>Instructors Declaration</u> To be signed by all Listed Instructors

Agreeing to the following declaration is a requirement of advertising as a listed instructor at UK Hoopers. We are committed to ensuring that the public find quality, reputable instructors to lead them on their hoopers journey. We understand that different people look for different qualities and specialisms in an instructor and we ask you to open a dialogue with each potential new client to ascertain that you are the best fit for them. By signing this declaration and advertising with UK Hoopers we are able to reassure clients that any trainer they contact is running a legitimate, insured business and that they are in safe and above all competent and capable hands.

- 1) You have undertaken sufficient and relative training to equip you with the skills and knowledge to offer meaningful instruction in the sport of Canine Hoopers.
- 2) You offer positive, reward based training only
- 3) You are committed to educating your clients in kind, ethical and force free ownership and handling methods
- 4) You maintain good ethics
- 5) You will put the wellbeing of any dog or client before any financial or commercial decision.
- 6) You will not bring the sport of Canine Hoopers nor UK Hoopers into disrepute
- 7) You agree to receive client feedback & recommendations via the UK Hoopers platform
- 8) You hold suitable insurance for the activities which you undertake
- 9) You are not banned from keeping or working with animals or people of any type
- 10) You will use only equipment, which is safe, suitable and appropriate.
- 11) You do not permit the use of choke, full check, electric or prong collars within your training establishment.
- 12) You will always show courtesy and respect to all others
- 13) You shall not be party to any form of public degradation towards others within the sport
- 14) You offer your services in good faith, at all times
- 15) You will show no prejudice towards any human or canine client.
- 16) You will work with any client to find an alternative instructor or professional should their requirements be outside of your remit (eg. if you feel a qualified behaviourist is required and you are not one)
- 17) You accept that there are many variations to the sport of Canine Hoopers within the UK and endeavour to inform your clients relative to their needs and wishes
- 18) You actively seek continuous personal and professional development to refresh and advance your own skills.
- 19) You promote the safe enjoyment of the sport of Canine Hoopers

- 20) You engage only in a professional and sportsmanlike manner
- 21) You are committed to acting with honesty and integrity and in the best interest of all parties.
- 22) You confirm that all qualifications and certificates listed have been attained by you.
- 23) You understand that UK Hoopers is providing an advertising platform only
- 24) All information posted on your profile is an accurate and correct representation.
- 25) You take full responsibility for your online account
- 26) You understand that any devaitation from the above will result in your advertising profile being removed from the UK Hoopers website
- 27) You understand that by advertising on the UK Hoopers website you are placing your business details on a publicly accessible website
- 28) If you include another persons details within your business listing you confirm that they meet the above criteria also and that you have permission to do so on their behalf.
- 29) You understand that UK Hoopers takes no responsibility for the content, accuracy, availability or any other element of your listing or data and that this service may be removed at any time.
- 30) You agree to continue to comply with the above criteria and will inform UK Hoopers immediately of any changes.
